The dress rehearsal is mandatory for all students dancing in the recital. Please ensure that dancers arrive on time and prepared (hair and makeup already done). Unfortunately, rehearsal on stage cannot wait for tardy students! We are aware that drop off time off 3:30pm might be a challenge for some families, we ask that you consider early dismissal from school or arrange carpooling in order to arrive on time. Thank you for understanding.

Please drop off and pick up at the backstage door by the west doors to the building (beside the café).

Parents and family members will not be allowed to attend the Dress Rehearsal. This is due to the rental restrictions placed on us by the venue. We will take good care of your children.

Dress Rehearsal & Show Day Prep

HAIR

Pease keep an eye on your email for information regarding the hairstyle the dancers require for the Dress Rehearsal and Recital. Most frequently, they will require a Ballet bun (at the crown of the head), a low ponytail (parted) or simple braids. Please ask them if you have questions. For all students, hair must be slick with no clips or bright-coloured elastics. Elastics and hair nets should match the dancer's hair colour, and you will need lots of hairspray.

MAKEUP

We require that our dancers wear stage makeup because the intensity of the stage lighting washes out their faces and hides their expressions and performance. All stage performers must learn to properly apply stage makeup and get comfortable wearing it.

We have filmed a tutorial on applying stage makeup for our purposes. You can access it on our webpage under the "Registration" menu, on the "Dance Attire & Videos" page. You can also go to Youtube and search "Crossings Dance" or click <u>here</u> to watch it now.

We ask that our students wear foundation that matches their skin colour, blush (along cheek bones), eye shadow (natural tones, darkest colour in the eyelid crease), black eye liner (top and bottom), mascara, and lipstick (reds or dark pinks).

TO BRING

Students should bring a water bottle, and they can also bring a snack. <u>Please refrain from any food</u> <u>containing nuts</u>, as there are students with severe allergies, and please don't send anything with the potential to make a big mess or stain. We also ask dancers to wear a zip front hoodie they can put on over their costume (without going over their head and frizzing up their hair) to prevent water and snacks from getting on the costumes.

Please leave valuables and jewelry at home. This includes earrings, as they should not be worn on stage. Please also remember no fingernail polish or toenail polish, no stick-on tattoos, and no drawing on skin. All of these things can be distracting to the audience and take away from the story you are telling on stage.

Student Arrival & Recital/Showcase Processes

The drop off location (backstage door) is located inside First Alliance Church by the café and west entrance. Look for dancers and our Crossing table and you will know you are in the right place!

While we greatly appreciate when students are on time, arriving early can cause us more traffic issues. Please be prepared to wait in the foyer/café with your dancer until the time they are required to be at their rehearsal.

When you arrive with your dancer, you will need to sign them in (or if they're older, they can check themselves in), and you will be asked to leave them at the backstage door by the café. Older dancers will be sent to find their class on their own. Younger dancers will be given to a Runner who will deliver them to their Class Moms. Dancers will also be signed out at the time of pickup. **Please do not encourage your young dancer to run to you from the backstage door.** You will need to approach the desk and sign them out.

No Early Dismissal

It is important to note that we are not able to permit dancers to leave earlier than the time indicated for pick up. This includes at the Dress Rehearsal, and on the show day at Intermission. You have trusted us to care for your children, and this requires that we know where each dancer is and who is supervising them.

To ensure the safety of our dancers, it is important that <u>the only adults permitted</u> <u>backstage are Crossings staff or identified volunteers</u>. In order to go through the backstage door, one must either be a dancer or be wearing a volunteer name tag. Staff will be identified in the same way.

VICTORIA DAY

Crossings will remain open and classes run as usual on Victoria Day, Monday, May 20th (Victoria Day). It is one week before Recital, so it is important for all students to be in class.

NO CLASSES

There are no classes Thursday, May 30th and Friday, May 31st. We need some time to recover from all the work that goes into the big show and to get ready for Photo Week!

PHOTO WEEK

Photo Week and the last week of classes will be Monday, June 3rd – Saturday June 8th. For classes that are more than once a week, a detailed list of which class parents should come to will be sent home later this month. Students are asked to come to class with their hair and make-up done. They will get dressed in their recital costumes, and parents are invited to attend class to take their own photos. We will not be offering professional photos of this year's recital and **photography/video is <u>NOT permitted</u> during the recital**.
